

Institutional Values and Best Practices

The department supports the objectives of the University of maintaining a green and clean campus. A garden is maintained in the Department and the students regularly help in keeping it clean as well as plant trees in the campus as part of the Student Society activities and Swatchata Abhiyan activities initiated by the University during Swatchata Pakhwada. These activities help nurture environmental consciousness in students.

The Department also adopts good practices and two practices that have immensely helped students in their professional development are:

Earn While Learn Program: The students of the Department participate in this program and spend 1-2 hours daily in the Central Library of the University. They are assigned different tasks and a record of their daily progress is maintained at the library. They are paid for it on hourly basis. This provides the students an opportunity to earn while learning. This program not only provides field training and financial support to students but also helps to build their confidence which has helped the students to fare well in the interviews at the time of placement.

Alumni Involvement: It has been a practice in the Department to encourage alumni to visit the Department and interact with the students. The alumni share their field experience with the students and this guidance helps the students to prepare for their professional life. It has also helped in strengthening the bond between the students and the alumni, which is very helpful for the students when they start building their career.
