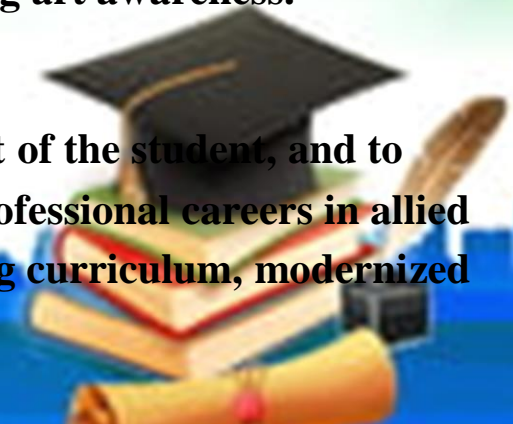

Department of Fine Arts and Performing Arts previously known as Youth Welfare & Cultural Activities Department, is the only one of its kind in Madhya Pradesh. The department started its journey on 1st May 1964. In due course of time the department started facilitating training in cultural activities. From the year 1988 to 2010 the Department of Youth Welfare Cultural activities and Performing arts conducted P.G. Diploma in Performing Arts. This department started working under the School of Arts and Information Sciences (AIS) with the name of Department of Fine Arts and Performing Arts since 2009. From 2014-15 onwards the Department is offering courses such as B.A. with Theatre Art, Bachelor of Fine Arts (BFA) with specialization in Applied Arts, Master of Performing Arts & Theatre Arts. Programs offered -

1. BFA (Bachelor of Fine arts) -25 seats,

Eligibility /Criteria:-

- **The minimum eligibility for BFA in 10+2 examination with minimum 45% marks.**
- **For BFA program, the candidate has to appear in CUET entrance examination also.**

2. Ph.D In Fine Arts

Eligibility /Criteria:-

- **The Minimum eligibility for Ph.D in Fine Arts in the qualified in NET/JRF/SEL in Visual Arts.**
- **The minimum eligibility for Ph.D Fine Arts(Painting, Applied Arts Sculpture , History of Arts) in the graduation in any discipline of Fine Arts & Visual Arts , with 55% marks.**
- **For Program the candidate has to appear in PhD entrance examination.**

Placement in Fine Arts:-

After completing graduation, BFA -students have a choice to work as an art teacher, artist in government office or photographer. Students can also start their career as a freelance worker & go for direction, clothing, photography, television and fashion. They can also pursue careers in academia, architecture, and the film industry. They can join creative departments of magazines, advertising agencies, and newspapers in the publishing or the textile industry. The fine artist's work is to produce artwork by using a wide variety of media and techniques.

3. MPA (Master of performing Arts)- 25 Seats,

- **The minimum eligibility for MPA in Theatre Arts is graduation in any discipline, with 45% marks.**
- **For MPA Program the candidate has to appear in CUET (PG) entrance examination**

Ph.D In Fine Performing Arts.

Eligibility /Criteria:-

- **The Minimum eligibility for Ph.D in Performing Arts in the qualified in NET/JRF/SELT in Performing Arts.(Theatre)**
- **The minimum eligibility for Ph.D Performing Arts.(Theatre. Drama , History of Theatre) in the graduation in any discipline of Fine Arts & Performing Arts , with 55% marks.**
- **For Program the candidate has to appear in PhD entrance examination.**



Placement in performing Arts:-

One can be employed as Actor, Choreographer, Set Designer, Drama Therapist, Theatre Director, Singer, Theatre Arts Teacher, Screenwriter, Stage Manager, and Broadcasting Presenter.
