kill enhancement provides a great opportunity to the students to develop their knowledge which they need to acquire and refine vital skills that are necessary for gaining, keeping, and growing a profession in a specific field. Learning and growing, however, are hallmarks of personal and professional development for all people, including students. The Community College of Dr Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya (A Central University), Sagar (MP) organized a one-day fair based on this rationale to encourage students to exhibit and sell their products. Students from nineteen courses (Diploma Course in Mushroom Cultivation and Processing: Diploma Course in Retail Management; Fashion Technology Designing and Management; Tourism; Food Processing and Management; Historical Tourism and Tourism Guiding; Water Purification; Social Accountability and Social Audit; Bioinformatics; Professional Office Executive; Bio-Pesticide Production and Management; Paper and Plastic Waste Recycling and Management; Guidance & Counseling; Psychology of Health & Well-Being; Professional Communication; Composting Techniques; Organic Farming; Management and Entrepreneurship and Wheat Processing) participated in the fair and their skills through exhibition of materials. Approximately 6000 people attended the event, where students interacted with them and also sold their products, which cost about Rs. 85000.00, at twelve different counters. Hon'ble Dr Prakash Batunia, Chancellor, Babasahab Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh, inaugurated the fair, which was chaired by Hon'ble Prof. Neelima Gupta, Vice Chancellor, Dr. HarisinghGour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar (MP). The fair was organized under the steward leadership of Shri Santosh Sahgora, Registrar, Dr. Harisingh GourVishwavidyalaya, Sagar and Nodal Officer Prof Shweta Yadav, Professor, Department of Zoology, Dr Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar (MP). The students Mr Ram Sewak Kushwaha, who is pursuing a course in Composting technique, Mr Anil Yadav, who is pursuing a course in Organic farming practices and certification course, and Smt Rubina Khan, Ms Payal, and Ms Laxmi Pareta, who are pursuing a course in fashion design and technology, have started their own business units and shared their success stories at the event.

The fair was organized with the following specific goals:

- To teach market-relevant skills in areas such as clothing, home decor, food, biofertilizers, mushrooms, and their by-products.
- To build entrepreneurial skills in students so that they can launch their entrepreneurial venture as soon as they finish their courses.
- To teach students employability skills so that they can compete in a competitive job market.
- To offer students with important life skills that will help them to cope with the demands of entrepreneurship, such as social and interpersonal skills.
- To assist students, gain self-confidence, develop critical thinking skills, nurture independence, and improve their communication skills.
- Approximately 6000 people attended the exhibition, and students sold Rs. 85000 worth of merchandise.

The product was reduced down from waste materials such as discarded containers, plastic bottles and water bottles, which piqued the interest of the audience. He shared his startup journey with the audience, telling them that he has hired 12 workers at his Vermicomost Unit in Sagar, that Vermicompost is sailing smoothly, and that he pays 1.5 lakhs GST

annually on the product's sale. During the occasion, he sold vermiwash and vermicomposting for Rs 9418.00. He not only sold the items, but also gave a live demonstration of how Vermicompost and Vermiwash are made and packaged. The live presentation of the technique drew a lot of attention from the audience. The counter was monitored by course coordinator Prof Shweta Yadav of the Department of Zoology.






