

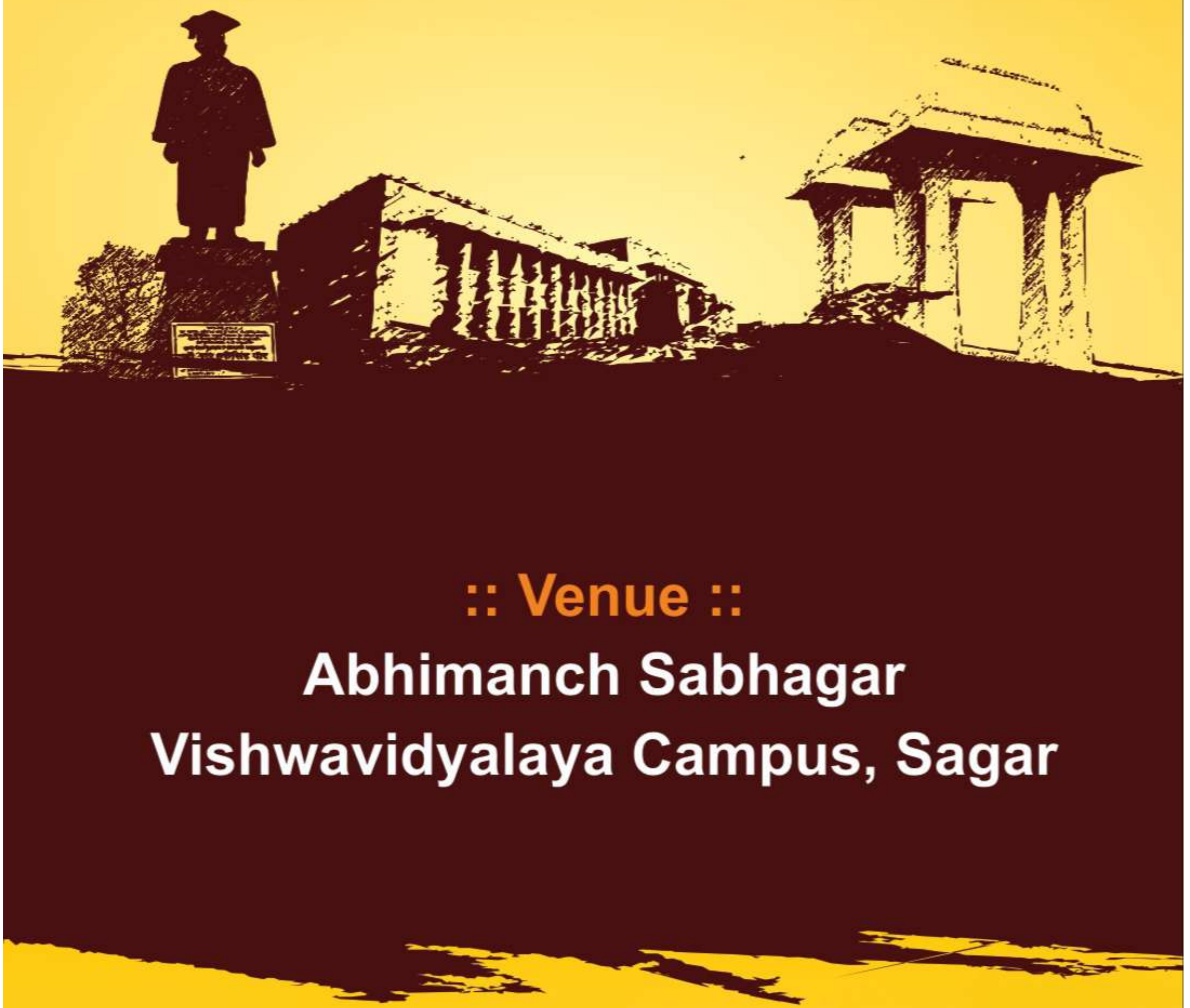

# Introduction

Innovation means finding new ways to meet the needs and demands of the library users or community and bring qualitative development and value addition to the library and information services. An innovative librarian explores, applies, and discovers applications to change the system which has more impact on a new way of providing services. Innovations in library and information services are a conscious and planned activity to create competition among the libraries, and user satisfaction by maintaining international standards and benchmarks through professional accountability.

Changes in the workplace in a digital/virtual environment have compelled library and information professionals to reorient themselves and compete in the global market as well. This has necessitated a radical change in LIS education and training keeping in view the need for the library and information workforce required in the national/global market. It has 36 University teaching departments (number keeps adding) 11 schools and 19 affiliated colleges covering various districts of M.P. The University is developing in a congenial peaceful disciplined and enthusiastic atmosphere. The students and teachers of the University are ever conscious of the burden of responsibility placed on them by the dreams of a great visionary who had kindled "the light that never fails."

## About the Department of LIS

The present department of Library & Information Science was established in 1970 on the occasion of centenary year of Dr. Harisingh Gour, the founder of the University and its first Vice Chancellor. It has been imparting regular Graduate Degree Programme in Bachelor of Library & Information Science since its inception, Post Graduate Degree Programme of Master of Library & Information Science since 1983 and Ph.D. programme of study since 1987. Many stalwarts of Library and Information Science such as Prof. H.S. Sengar, Prof. R.G. Prasher, Prof. K.C. Sahoo, Prof. Jagtar Singh, Dr. B.P. Shrivastava have served this Department. The Department under teachers' dynamic leadership and contribution has achieved its own place within the country.

## About the Library

Jawaharlal Nehru Library, Dr. Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya Sagar (Central University) is the oldest and Largest University Library situated in the Sagar district of Madhya Pradesh. It is located at the Centre of the University Teaching Departments to help the users for better and regular use of the library. The Library has 3 Story's Stack area designed to accommodate 4 lacs volumes with an extension wing and a seminar hall. The present building foundation stone was laid down by the former Prime Minister Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru.
