The University

Dr. Harisingh Gour University, Sagar was founded at Sagar on 18 July 1946 by the sole initiative and donation of Sir Hari Singh Gour. He was the founder Vice Chancellor of this University, a legal stalwart and a member of Constituent Assembly of India. University of Saugor became a Central University in 2009. Located on the Vindhyachal range of mountain, this university has a picturesque location and is the largest University in the Central region and has 1500 acres of land. The University has a post office, library, internet lab, =hospital, gym, hostels for girls and boys, shopping centre, canteen, guest house and residential quarters for teachers. The University has earned A+ grade from National Assessment and Accreditation Council. It currently has 11 schools and 36 teaching departments. School of Humanities and Social Science consists of the Departments of Philosophy, Psychology, Political Science and Public Administration, Sociology and Social Work, Economics, History and Ancient Indian History, Culture and Archaeology. Teaching of humanities and social science subjects were initiated in the Faculties of Arts and Science since the inception of the University in 1946. However, various Departments were formally instituted in the Faculties of the University at different points of time. The Department of Political Science and Public Administration has been functioning since 1946.

About Us

The department has rich tradition of academic excellence in the field of Political Science and Public Administration and has produced many stalwarts in the discipline.

It was one of the pioneering departments in the field of Public Administration in the country. Students of the department have qualified UGC NET, SLET and received Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship and UGC JRF. They have also cleared IAS and MPPCS. The department regularly organizes lectures by eminent scholars such as Prof. S.D. Muni, Prof Priyankar Upadhyay, and Prof Santishree Dulipudy. Department also organizes workshops, student parliament Gandhi Jayanti etc.
