EC-XXXVII-(III)-(i): Adoption of UGC instructions regarding Internal Revenue Generation (IRG) and its effective utilization by Central Universities (CUs).

The UGC vide its D.O. letter No.4-10/2023(CU)/133232 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024 has requested the University to take appropriate action regarding Internal Revenue Generation (IRG) and its effective utilization on the recommendation of the Expert Committee as approved by the UGC and Ministry of Education.

The key recommendations with regard to IRG are as follows:

- Central universities can utilize IRG under salary Head (36) and capital Assets Head (35) only after meeting all committed liabilities under Recurring Head (31) and repayment of its share (Principal part) of HEFA loans.
- The universities should have their own internal mechanism to ensure effective utilization of IRG.
- The ratio of IRG funds to the total budget coming from the Government should be a key matrix to determine the performance of an institute.
- The universities should make serious efforts to generate internal revenue through donations from industry, philanthropists and alumni.
- Alumni Endowment Fund should be promoted.
- Available resources (such as, commercial spaces, banks premises, guest house etc.) should be properly utilized by the Universities for raising internal revenue.
- The universities should make efforts to get consultancy and sponsored projects from the industry.

The minimum qualification prescribed by AICTE Regulations, 2019 for the position of Director was given in the advertisement. It was also mentioned in the Advertisement that the Vishwavidyalaya intends to appoint a retired Professor/ Officer of any reputed Technical Institute/ Industry on a contractual basis on a consolidated salary of Rs.1 Lakh per month. But, despite the wider publicity, only 03 applications were received and after scrutiny, none of them could be found eligible.

The Commission, in agreement with the University, would advise declining of sanction of prosecution against Shri N.S. - iii. End Semester Examination 70%

The Institute of Engineering and Technology (IoET) in line with the AICTE Model Curriculum for the UG Degree Course in Computer Science and Engineering as per NEP 2020 implemented the evaluation scheme for the theory part from Academic Session 2023-24 in the following manner:

The weightage of internal assessment is 40% and for end semester exam is 60%. The student has to obtain at least 40% marks individually both in internal assessment and end semester exam to pass.

The examination has already been conducted but the result has not so far been declared for want of formal approval to amendment in Ordinance 63.

The section 43(3) of the Central Universities, Act, 2009, stipulates that the power to make Statutes, Ordinances, or Regulations shall include the power to give retrospective effect, from a date not earlier than the date of commencement of this Act, but no retrospective effect shall be given so as to prejudicially affect the interest of any person to whom such Statutes, Ordinances or Regulations may be applicable.

In the instant matter, the interest of the students is involved; the EC is empowered to make amendments to the Ordinance as proposed from the Academic Session 2023-24.
