About the Vishwavidyalaya

Doctor Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya was initially established as *University of Saugor* on 18th July 1946 by Dr. Hari Singh Gour, a great visionary and a social reformer with an unparalleled professional profile. He is renowned as an eminent legal luminary, an orator par excellence and above all a humanist at heart. Dr. Gour had humble beginnings in early life but with his exceptional talent and perseverance, he achieved unprecedented heights and donated a handsome amount from his life savings for this University, established with the vision of education and upliftment of the backward sections of society. It is one of the oldest and biggest universities in Madhya Pradesh, spread across 1312.89 acres of spectacular campus with 11 Schools, 38 University Teaching Departments, 15 Centres, 17 Affiliated Colleges and 6 Hostels. The Central Jawaharlal Nehru Library, enriched with more than 3,80,000 books and a good number of journals are connected with INFLIBNET. The Vishwavidyalaya was upgraded to the status of a central university in 2009 by an act of Parliament and achieved 'A+' grade in accreditation by NAAC in 2022.

The Department of Education

The Department of Education came into existence in the year 1961 and till 1967 functioned as a M.P. Government's Post Graduate Basic Training (PGBT) College. In 1967, it was upgraded as "University College of Education". After the up-gradation of the university into a Central University on 15 January 2009, this University College of Education with all its entities and amenities was transformed into the present 'Department of Education' under the aegis of a separate school "School of Educational Studies (SES)" on 27 March 2011.

Further, the Department has been upgraded into School of Education under the scheme of Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) of Ministry of Education (then MHRD) having two centres namely Centre for Pre-Service Teacher Education (CPSTE) & Centre for Professional Development of Teacher Educators (CPDTE). The Department of Education currently offers different teacher education programmes namely B.A. B.Ed. & B.Sc. B.Ed. (4 Year Integrated and Innovative Programme), Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP), M.Ed. and also liberal programmes of education namely B.A. (Education) and M.A. (Education) along with Ph.D. (Education) programme.

Capacity Building Programme

The Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) play a pivotal role in shaping individuals' intellectual growth, fostering innovation, and driving socio-economic development. In today's rapidly evolving landscape, continuous professional development is essential for educators to upgrade their professional and ethical competencies. The present Capacity Building Programme (CBP) is considered as a programme for professional development for teachers working in the higher education. The present CBP has been designed to encourage the faculty members to use interdisciplinary teaching methodologies in their teaching, training and research for catering the diverse learning styles, backgrounds, and abilities of learners.

The present CBP will be a comprehensive platform for the faculties of social sciences to develop their pedagogical and research competencies. Such programmes are vital for promoting excellence in teaching, developing professional capabilities of faculty members, improving research outputs, and ultimately contributing to the development of a robust educational ecosystem. This programme aims to give exposure to in-service faculty, preferably lecturers/assistant professors in social science disciplines, to get exposure to the recent advancements in teaching, training and research with the exposure to Indian Knowledge Systems apart from contemporary approaches.

Objectives of the Programme

The broad objective of the proposed CBP is to provide training in social science research methodology to the teachers of social science disciplines like Education, Economics, Sociology, Political Science, Social Work, Geography, and History etc. More specifically the CBP aims to address the following aspects -

- Develop understanding on philosophy of teaching, training and research.
- Develop different teaching and evaluation methodologies and competencies in teachers.
- Enhance skills to prepare an appropriate research proposal, including conducting an overview of literature, formulating research questions and hypotheses, collection of information and analysis.
- Help them to understand the application of appropriate statistical techniques in various types of researches keeping in mind the nature of the data.
- Enhance the capability for planning and writing a teaching portfolio/research paper and book etc.
- To acquaint the participants with the latest developments and trends in the field of social science research.

Who can apply?

- SCAN TO REGITER
- The Lecturer / Assistant Professor from the social science disciplines in a UGC-recognized Indian university/deemed to be university/college/institute of national importance may apply through the given link/QR code.
- There should be at least thirty (30) participants from social science disciplines, out of which ten (10) must be from the city, ten (10) from the state and ten (10) from outside the state.
- The declaration of participant with the forwarding of the Head of the Institution is mandatory to participate in the CBP.

Facts to be consider

- The last date for receiving the online applications for Capacity Building Programme will be **January 15 2025** and it will be conducted only in face-to-face mode.
- The participants are requested to come with laptop for hands-on-training activities.
- There will be **No Registration Fee** for the CBP.
- The outstation participants are entitled for accommodation on sharing basis and travelling allowance subject to the maximum of upto Rs. 3000/- (to and fro) against the original travelling bills.
- The food and other refreshments are free for all the selected participants of CBP.
- The selection of the participants will be made as per the CBP guidelines of ICSSR, New Delhi.
- The selected participants will have to accept the offer for participating in the CBP through email by the due date, failing which the waitlisted applicants may be given the chance.
- The CBP may be considered for the eligibility under the Career Advancement Scheem (CAS) as per the UGC Regulation 2018.

How to reach at Sagar?

Sagar (M.P.) is a divisional head quarter, well connected by train and all season roads. The nearest airport is in Bhopal and Jabalpur at a distance of 175 Kms. approx. The Sagar railway station is mentioned as Saugor (SGO) in the railway time-table. Sagar is directly connected by train to Bina (80 Kms), Bhopal (215 Kms), Katni (), Jabalpur (279 Kms) and Jhansi (200 Kms).
