- 2. The term of present Vice Chancellor Prof. Neelima Gupta is going to expire on 06.09.2025 consequent upon her attaining the age of 70 years.
- 3. As per Statute 2 of the Central University Act, 2009, the Vice Chancellor is appointed by the Visitor from a panel recommended by a Committee consisting of five persons, out of whom three are nominated by the Executive Council and two by the Visitor and one of the nominees of the Visitor is the convener of the Committee. Provided that none of the members of the Committee shall be an employee of the University or a College or an Institution maintained by the University or a member of any authority of the University.

EC-XL-(IV)- The issue of the appointment of Sh. Sunil Kumar as Assistant Registrar on a (iv): Deputation Basis.

Mr. Sunil Kumar applied for the post of Assistant Registrar against Advt.No. R/NT/2024-01 dated 07-03-2024. In his application dated 16-06-2024, Sh. Sunil Kumar claimed his experience as Section Officer in Aryabhatt Knowledge University, Patna, in Pay Level-7 w.e.f. 03-09-2013. The qualification prescribed for the post in the said advertisement is as follows:

#### **Essential Qualification:**

- a) Master's Degree with at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed.
- b) Officers holding analogous posts on regular basis or with 5 years regular service in lower grades position in Level-7/Level-8 in the Central/State Government, Universities and other autonomous organization. Knowledge of Computer Applications.

The last date of receipt of the application was 14-07-2024. As per the clause

29(v) of the advertisement, "Qualification/Experience/Age, etc", will be counted as on the last date of submission of application.

The Screening Committee, after screening of his application, recommended him provisionally eligible, subject to submission of Experience Certificate, NoC, and Vigilance Clearance Certificate. On his request, Mr. Sunil Kumar was allowed to appear in the interview on 19-02-2025 online. On the basis of performance in the interview, the Selection Committee unanimously recommended that he be appointed as Assistant Registrar on a Deputation Basis. The Executive Council in its 39th Meeting held on 20-02-2025 vide item No.EC-XXXIX-(III)-(i) unanimously approved the recommendation of the Selection Committee. On 21-02-2025, Mr. Sunil Kumar was asked to submit an Experience Certificate, No Objection Certificate (NoC), and Vigilance Clearance Certificate (VCC). In response to it, Mr. Sunil Kumar submitted the requisite documents vide his e-mail dated 04-03-2025. Even from the said documents, it was not clear as to which date he was serving in Pay Level-7. Then he was informed by the concerned Section of the Vishwavidyalaya to submit the documents indicating the exact date from which he was serving in Pay Level-7. In response to which, Mr. Sunil Kumar vide his e-mail dated 18-03-2025 submitted a certificate dated 17-03-2025 issued by the Registrar of Aryabhatt Knowledge University, Patna. The certificate dated 17-03-2025 clearly states that Mr. Sunil Kumar has been working as a Section Officer since 03-09-2013 in the pay scale of Rs.9300-34800/- (GP-4200/-) Level-6. He has been promoted in the Pay Scale of Rs.9300-34800/- (GP-4600/-) Level-7 with effect from 03-09-2019 at present GP-50500/-. From the said certificate, it is evident that Mr. Sunil Kumar possessed 04 Years 09 Months of experience in Pay Level-7, whereas the required experience was 5 Years in Pay Level-7 as on the last date of receipt of application. Taking into account these facts, Mr. Sunil Kumar was not issued an appointment order for the post of Assistant Registrar on a Deputation Basis.

#### Resolution:

The Council, after due deliberations, resolved not to issue an appointment order to Mr. Sunil Kumar as he does not fulfill the qualifications for the post of Assistant Registrar on deputation as prescribed in the advertisement and Cadre Recruitment Rules 2022.

It is further informed to the Council that a Committee consisting of a Professor from Commerce Department as a Chairman with Finance Officer, a Senior Account Officer from UGC and Deputy Registrar, dealing with the establishment matter of the teachers examined the request of these faculty members

regarding pay protection and found in order in light of DoPT OM F.No.12/2/2017-Estt.(Pay-1) dated 05/08/2020 and UGC letter F.No.22-9/2017 (CU) dated 01/05/2018 as adopted by the Executive Council of the Vishwavidyalaya in its 36th Meeting held on 22/07/2024. The Internal Audit of the Vishwavidyalaya also found the Pay Fixation as mentioned in the last column of the table in order. Presently, these teachers are drawing a minimum of the pay admissible to the post on which he/she has been appointed.

**Resolution:** 

The Council, after due deliberations, resolved to protect the pay of the Faculty Members who have been confirmed. The cases of pay protection of the faculty members who are still on probation or left the University during probation may be reviewed and put up again in the next meeting.

EC-XL-(IV)- The Report of the Committee regarding issue an Expression of Interest (EoI) to install a Cellular Signal Tower on the University Campus.

It is informed to the Council that in its 39th Meeting held on 20/02/2025 vide item No.EC:XXXIX:(III)-(iv) the Executive Council resolved to constitute a Committee under the Chairmanship of EC Member Dr. Abhishek Bansal and IT Officers of the Vishwavidyalaya as members. Further, the UGC Chairman nominee, Prof. Atul M. Gonsai, was an Advisor for this Committee. The Committee so constituted held its Meeting on 04/04/2025 and prepared an Expression of Interest (EoI). The key features of the EoI are as follows:

- The details proposal for the entire setup (site survey) is required to be submitted by the bidders along with the technical bid for tech evaluation. No payment shall be made to the agency for conducting the survey. Merely conducting the survey will not make the company entitled to claim for the installation of the mobile tower on the campus.
- 2. The contract will be awarded to the service provider who will submit the highest base rent (H1) in the commercial bid.
- 3. The telecom solutions based on current and future requirements of network coverage are to be installed at different parts of the campus. This is to be decided based on a proper survey of the campus.
- 4. In case the communication tower of the facilities so installed by the service provider causes any interference/obstruction to the Army/Air Force/other security forces communications, the service provider may be asked to discontinue his services, for which no compensation will be given to the service premises.

Resolution: The Council, after due deliberations, resolved to approve the recommendations of the Committee under the captioned agenda.

passed by the Hon'ble High Court of M.P. at Jabalpur in WP No.1683 of 2017, Dr. Vandana Rajoria Vs Dr. Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya and Others along with connected Writ Petitions affirmed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order dated 22-04-2025 in SLP No.2163/2019.

It is informed to the Council that the following candidates were appointed as Assistant Professor against Rolling Advertisement dated 30-10-2010 on the basis of their Ph.D. degree on the recommendations of duly constituted Selection Committees:

That these teachers were terminated from service in year 2014 under the orders of the then acting Vice-Chancellor on the ground that they did not have NET/SLET i.e. the minimum eligibility for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor. They also approached the Hon'ble High Court of M.P. by way of WP No.11934/2014 and connected Writ Petitions in which Hon'ble High Court directed the Executive Council to individually examine the eligibility of each affected candidate. The matter was placed in the EC held on 14-05-2015 and as per EC resolution a Committee consisting of distinguished academicians was constituted to determine the eligibility of these Assistant Professors vis-a-vis eligibility criteria stipulated in UGC Regulations 2010 and also contained in the letter No.F.9-3/2010 (PS)/Misc. Dated 20.11.2012 of the UGC. The Committee after perusal of whole records was of the opinion that these Assistant Professors were not eligible. The report of the Committee was placed before the Executive Council in its meeting dated 25-08-2015 and the EC resolved to refer the cases of these Assistant Professors to the Hon'ble Visitor through MHRD for his consideration and final order. In pursuance of the above mentioned resolution of the EC, the cases of these Assistant Professors were referred to the MHRD

(now Ministry of Education) vide University letter No.R/2015/823 dated 27/11/2015. After considering the matter, the President of India in his capacity as Visitor of the Vishwavidyalaya accepted the resolution of the Council and directed to take consequent action as communicated by MHRD vide letter F.No.56-4/2014-CU-IV dated 16-12-2016. The matter was placed before the Executive Council in its Emergent Meeting dated 10.02.2017 and the Council after due deliberation resolved to terminate the services of these teachers as they do not fulfill the eligibility criteria for the post of Assistant Professor at the time of their appointment in terms of UGC Regulations, 2010. Consequently 08 Assistant Professors were terminated vide order dated 13-02-2017. 02 Assistant Professors were not terminated due to interim stay order of Hon'ble High Court. They assailed the termination order before the Hon'ble High Court of M.P. at Jabalpur by way of WP No.1683/2017 and connected Writ Petitions. The Hon'ble High Court vide interim order dated 15-02-2017 restrained the University from discontinuing the services of the petitioners. In compliance with the interim order of the High Court, these teachers were allowed to continue their services. The matter was finally heard by the Hon'ble High Court of M.P. at Jabalpur in lead case No. WP 1683/2017 and vide order dated 16-08-2018 Hon'ble High Court of M.P. at Jabalpur disposed off the petitions with the following observations -

Since the Expert Committee has given its report on 23.8.2015 prior to the amendment published on 11.07.2016 and the Executive Council has failed to consider such amendment while accepting the report of the Expert Committee to terminate the services of the petitioner, therefore, we find that the action of the University is wholly untenable, illegal and against the UGC Regulations. Consequently, the decision of the Executive Council dated 10.02.2017 and the subsequent order of termination dated 13.02.2017 is set aside. The eligibility of the candidates may be considered by the Executive Council in the light of the UGC Regulations published on 11.07.2016 as to whether the petitioner fulfills the following conditions:

- a) Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- b) Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
- c) Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d) Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- e) Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D. work.
  - (a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs/Dean (University instructions).

The University assailed the order dated 16-08-2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of M.P. at Jabalpur in WP No.1683/2017 and other connected writ petitions before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India by way of SLP No.2163/2019, Dr. Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar, M.P., and another Vs.

Lame

Dr. Vandana Rajoria and Others on the ground that the UGC (4th Amendment) Regulations 2016 are not applicable in the case of petitioners as they were appointed in 2013 as per UGC Regulations 2010. However, the Special Leave Petitions (SLPs) filed by the University have been dismissed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide order dated 22-04-2025 and as such, the order dated 16-08-2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of M.P. at Jabalpur in WP No.1683/2017 and other connected writ petition has attained finality. All these 10 petitioners have moved their representations along with their Ph.D. degree and 5-point certificates regarding Ph.D. degree as per UGC (4th Amendment) Regulations 2016 published in the Gazette of India. They have also made a request to extend the consequential benefits.

In view of these 5-point certificates, the petitioners having a Ph.D. degree are exempted from the requirement of NET, and as such, they are eligible for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor.

Resolution:

When this agenda item was taken Prof. Devashish Bose recused himself from the meeting.

The Council, after due deliberations, resolved that a Committee be constituted to verify each case individually in light of orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court of M.P. and the report of the Committee be put up in the next meeting of EC for consideration.

The Under Secretary, Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of India, Ministry of Education, New Delhi, vide his letter F.No.56-2/2025-CU.IV dated 20-06-2025 has communicated inter-alia that the University while considering the agenda items must strictly follow the Rules and Regulations of Govt. of India and amendments/modifications issued there under from time to time especially those relating to the GFRs, DFPRs and the Guidelines/Instructions issued by Department of Expenditure, CVC etc. It is the sole responsibility of the University and its concerned officials to ensure strict compliance to the above mentioned extant rules, instructions and guidelines issued by GoI. The observations of the Ministry have been taken care of while discussing the agenda items.
