



Department of Yoga Education Dr. Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya, Sagar (M.P.) (Report of Student Feedback 2022-23)

- 1. Feedback was taken from the students of M.A./M.Sc. Yoga Education programmes for the Academic Session 2021-22 about by course by the IQAC. 13 studentss from M.A.Yoga Education and 4 students from M.Sc. Yoga Education participated in the survey. Although a total of 21 students were enrolled in both course but due to difficulty in online filing such as network issue, the students could not complete the survey online.
- 2. 55% Students in feedback have stated that the course provides sufficient knowledge and skills while 38% students consider it as excellent. 7% students termed it on average,
- 3. About the course structure and relevancy up to date 70% students find it good, 15% of them marked it excellent while 15% marked it average.
- 4. Regarding sequencing of unit of syllabus 49% students marked good, 21% marked it excellent, 30% students marked below average.
- 5. In relation to expected outcome of course 30% students found it below average& Average whereas 40% students found it very good and excellent.
- 6. Credit allocation category is highly appreciated with 45% students rating it Good and 26% rated it very good. While 29% found it below Average.
- 7. Regarding Viability in terms of Knowledge, Concept, Vocational Skill and broadening of perspective also, the students was highly praising the course with 63% marking itGood 37% marking it Excellent.
- 8. In terms of pre requisite learning, relevancy to technological advancements the students gave positive markings.
- 9. Regarding e-content study material of yoga the students were satisfied as 24% marked it average, 32% marked it good. 44% found it excellent.
- 10. Students praised the faculty being knowledgeable, honest, and sincere as 37% gave verygood marking while 37% mentioned it as excellent and 26% mark Good.
- 11. Regarding transparency in evaluation of answers sheets these was a mixed response with 10% and 50% found it excellent and very good while 40% said it was below average.
- 12. In view of the above feedback, IQAC and the Department has taken measures to make students aware about new system and a better turnout is expected in 2022-23 session.
- 13. Shortcomings regarding availability of e-content study material in library shall be strengthened and it will assure that sufficient material for reading and reference is made available for students. Experimental learning techniques will be strengthened.
