Report of Student Feedback (2021-22)

1. Feedback was taken from the students of B.Lib.I.Sc and M.Lib.I.Sc. programmes for the academic session 2021-22 about the courses by the IQAC. Fourteen (14) students from B.Lib.I.Sc. and nine (09) students from M.Lib.I.Sc. participated in the survey.

2. More than 90% students of M.Lib.I.Sc. and B.Lib.I.Sc. find the sequencing of units and

course usefulness to be good to excellent.

- 3. 86% students of B.Lib.I.Sc. 89% students of M.Lib.I.Sc. found the course coordinators knowledgeable, honest and sincere; and that due transparency was followed in evaluation of answer scripts. The course coordinators were also energetic and approachable. The students were encouraged for self learning.
- 4. However, 01 student of M.Lib.I.Sc. and 01 student of B.Lib.I.Sc., found some aspects of the course below average and were not satisfied with delivery of course content.
- 5. In 2020 the UGC-LOCF syllabus for B.Lib.I.Sc. was adopted in total and the response shows the students are satisfied with the course content.
- 6. IQAC and the Department took measures to make students aware about the new system of online feedback and this has led to increased participation by students in comparision to 2020-21. We expect much better participation from the students in the academic session 2022-23.
- 7. We have also restructured and redesigning the syllabus, of both B.Lib.I.Sc. and M.Lib.I.Sc., in accordance to NEP 2020 for academic session 2022-23 and also keeping the feedback of students of 2020-21 in mind. The syllabus will be further improved based on the feedback from the students of academic session 2021-22.
