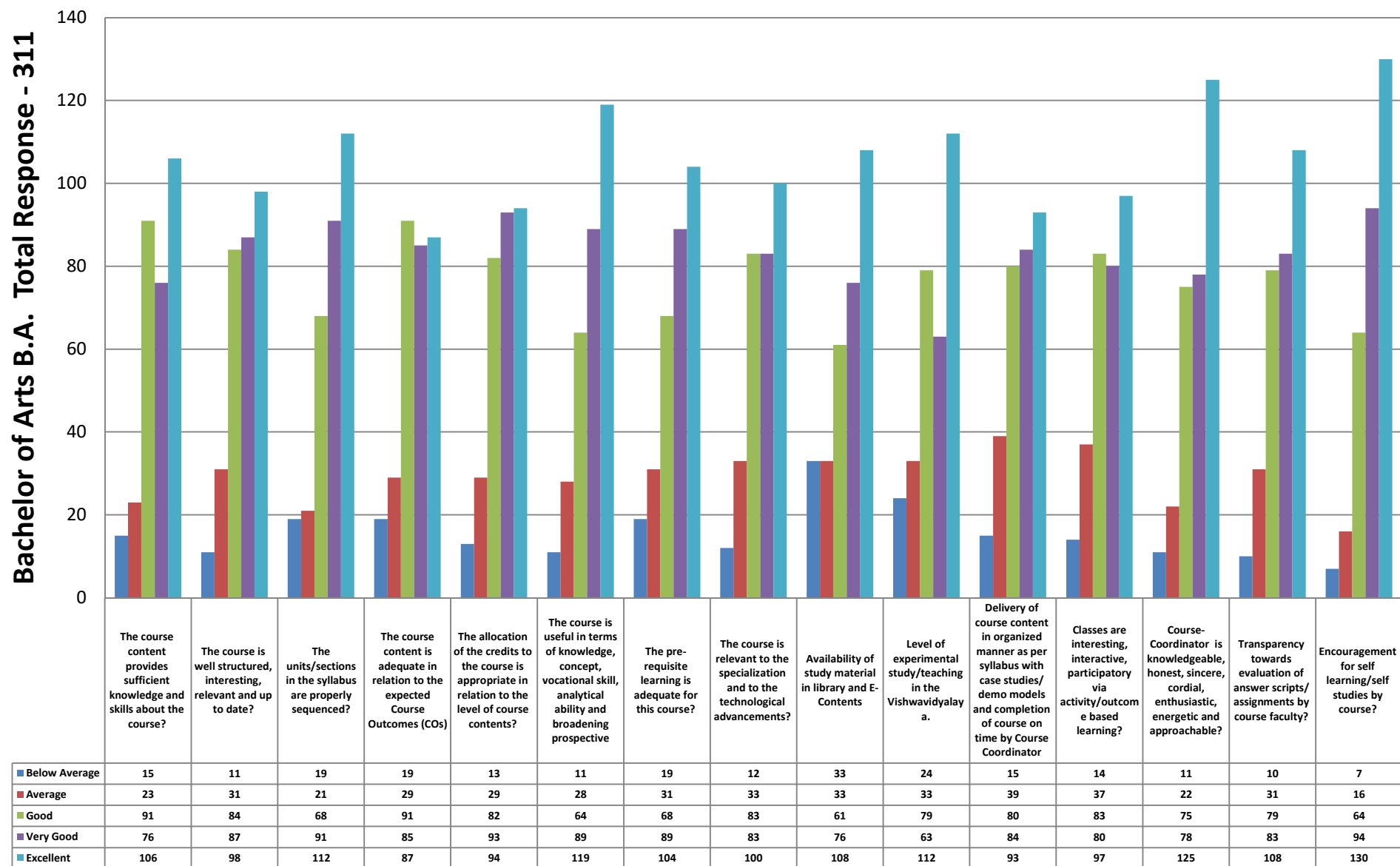


## 2021-22-STUDENT FEEDBACK

15 Questions were asked to the students for taking the students' feedback for the following questions. The no. of respondents was 311 and the responses were as follows:

**1- The course content provides sufficient knowledge and skills about the course?**

In these 106 students consider this as excellent, 76 as very good, 91 as good, 23 as average and 15 consider as below average.

**2- The course is well structured, interesting, relevant and up to date?**

In these 98 students consider it as Excellent, 87 as very good, 84 as good, 31 as an average and 11 consider this as below average.

**3- The units sections in the syllabus are properly sequenced?**

In these 112 students consider it as Excellent, 91 as very good, 68 as good, 21 as an average and 19 consider this as below average.

**4-The course content is adequate in relation to the expected course outcomes (COs)?**

In these 87 students consider it as Excellent, 85 as very good, 91 as good, 29 as an average and 19 consider this as below average.

**5- The allocation of the credits to the course is appropriate in relation to the level of course contents?**

In these 94 students consider it as Excellent, 93 as very good, 82 as good, and 29 consider average and 13 consider this as below average.

**6-The course is useful in terms of knowledge, concept, vocational skill, analytical ability and broadening prospective.**

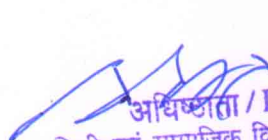
In these 119 students consider it as Excellent, 89 as very good, 64 as good, 28 as an average and 11 consider this as below average.

### **14-Transparency towards evaluation of answer scripts/ assignments by course faculty?**

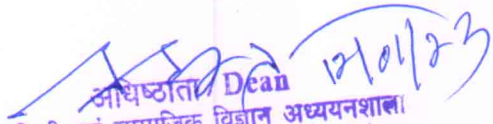
In these 108 students consider it as Excellent, 83 as very good, 79 as good, 31 as an average and 10 consider this as below average.
