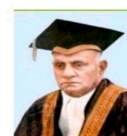

Event Report

A student- Teacher Open Forum organized by Dr. Preeti Wadhwani on 26th April 2019 at Maharshi Kannad Bhawan (DHSGU), Sagar

An interactive session of students with esteemed professors and administration of the DHSGU as Forum Panelist was organized as an initiative to enrich the academic culture of the university on 26th April 2019 at Maharishi Kannad Bhawan (G-4 New Lecture Complex) from 3:00 pm - 6:00 pm. Honorable VC Prof. P.P. Tiwari presided as the forum chairperson. Prof. AD Sharma (Dean, students Affair), Col. R.N Joshi (I/C Registrar and COE), Prof. G.L. Puntambekar (Dept of Commerce), Prof. Nivedita Maitra (Dean, school of language), Prof Naveen Kango (HoD Microbiology) were the Forum Panelist. The event was patronized by Prof G.S. Giri (Dean, School of Education).

Senior professors of the university Prof S.H Adil, Prof R.K Gangele, were present during the event. Dr. Budh Singh, Dr. Dharmendra Sarraf, Dr. Rashmi Jain from Dept. of Education were present at the event. Total 89 students from Dept of Education participated in the event (44 students of B.A.B.Ed., 45 students of B.Sc.B.Ed.). The stage activities were conducted by the class representative Mr. Parsoon Jain and Ms. Roma Soni. The list of participant students with their enrollment number is attached with the report.

The event began with release of Vishwavidyalaya RajBhasha Cell Annual magazine 'Bhasha Bharti'. Around 2500 questions on issues of Education System were framed by the participant students, out of which only 21 questions were screened by the organizer and the class representatives to be put to the forum. A major suggestion emerged was the formation of education commission on lines of election commission. विद्यार्थी का सुझाव भारत निर्वाचन आयोग की तर्ज पर शिक्षा आयोग की बने, कुलपति ने कहा-पूरा प्रस्ताव बनाकर दो, हम दिल्ली भेजेंगे

श्रीमंत गौर विश्वविद्यालय में विद्यार्थी और शिक्षकों के बीच संवाद के लिए गौर विश्वविद्यालय विशेष बजट मंच को शुरुआत की गई है। इसके तहत शिक्षा शास्त्र विभाग में इस पहले आयोजन में करीब 3 घंटे संवाद चला।

इस दौरान करीब 25 विद्यार्थी अपने सवाल लिखकर दिए। जिन्हें विद्यार्थियों ने बारी-बारी से पढ़ा। इनका जवाब विधि के कुलपति प्रो. कुलसचिव एवं विभिन्न विभागों के शिक्षकों और अधिकारियों प्रमुख प्रमुख ने सवाल किया



पर भारत शिक्षा आयोग भी बनना चाहिए। इस पर कुलपति प्रो. आरपी तिवारी ने कहा कि आप अपना ड्राफ्ट बनाकर भेजिए। शिक्षा आयोग कैसे काम करेगा। उसका अधिकार क्षेत्र क्या रहेगा। उसमें शिक्षा जगत को क्या लाभ होगा। इस तरह की कई बिंदुओं की समग्र जानकारी के साथ ड्राफ्ट दें। यदि यह सही लगा तो आगे

विकास मंत्रालय को भेजेंगे। उन्होंने कहा कि आखें मीस हैं तो चरमा रिसोर्स। इसीप्रकार कुर्सी, कम्प्यूटर आदि भी रिसोर्स हैं। व्यक्ति कभी भी संसाधन नहीं हो सकता।

एक विद्यार्थी ने सवाल किया कि शिक्षा का बजट 6 फीसदी क्यों नहीं हो पा रहा है? इस पर प्रो. जीएल पुणताविकर ने कहा कि अधिकांश लोग अब भी टैक्स नहीं भरते। जिससे

सरकार को ज्यादा आय नहीं हो पाती। जेआरएफ और पीएचडी वालों के बेरोजगारी धूमने के सवाल पर प्रो. नवीन कांगो ने कहा कि वर्तमान में शोध का स्तर गिर गया है। शोध ऐसा होना चाहिए जो समाज के लिए उपयोगी हो, जिसमें कुछ नया निकलकर आए तो आसानी से जाँच मिलेगी। एक विद्यार्थी के सवाल के जवाब में प्रो. निवेदिता मैत्रा ने कहा कि यह बात सही है कि सिर्फ किताबों से ही नैतिक मूल्यों को बढ़ाना पूरी तरह से संभव नहीं है। इसमें लिए आम जीवन में भी व्यवहारिक होना जरूरी है। डिजिटल लर्निंग पर लगातार बढ़ती निर्भरता से आखों सहित स्वास्थ्य को अन्य नुकसान को रोकने इसकी लिमिट तय करने

के सवाल के जवाब पर डॉ.एसडब्ल्यू प्रो. एडी शर्मा ने कहा कि यह नैतिक निर्णय का मुद्दा है। परंतु इसका कैसे और कितना उपयोग करना है यह हमें खुद भी तय करना चाहिए। प्रभारी कुलसचिव कर्नल राकेश मोहन जैसो ने भी सवालों के जवाब दिए। डॉन प्रो. जोएस गिरी भी मौजूद रहे। इस दौरान विधि के राजभाषा प्रकोष्ठ की वार्षिक वार्षिक पत्रिका भाषा भारती का विमोचन भी हुआ। इस मौके पर प्रो. एसएच आदिल, प्रो. आरके गंगुली, डॉ. छबील कुमार मेहर, डॉ. बुध सिंह, डॉ. धर्मेन्द्र सराफ, डॉ. रविम जैन आदि मौजूद थी। संचालन कक्षा प्रतिनिधि प्रमून जैन और रोमा सोनी ने किया।
