The universities, institutions, IITs and other national organizations may select the JRF awardees for full time research work in accordance with the procedure prescribed by them.

Economically Weaker Section(EWS)/Scheduled Caste(SC)/Scheduled Tribe(ST)/Persons with Disability(PwD)/ Transgender /Other Backward Classes -Non creamy layer (OBC-NCL), as per the central list of Other Backward Classes available on National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC), Government of India website: www.ncbc.nic.in, candidate will be given such special concessions as may be decided by the UGC.
