Interaction with International Faculty	
<p><u>Interaction of Host Faculty:</u></p> <p>Prof. Anand Paranjpe, emeritus Professor, Department of Psychology, Simon Frazer University, Canada was the international faculty in whose leadership the GIAN Programme entitled “Emotion, cognition and consciousness: The Eastern and Western Perspectives” was conducted during August 25-30, 2017. A total 45 (24 males and 21 females) participants joined the programme out of which 12 participants belonged to different parts of the country. In consonance with the major theme of the programme, the lectures and tutorials with productive interactions by resource person were organized on Indian and Western views of consciousness, emotion and cognition which lucidly explained the nature, genesis, development and impacts of Indian and Western thoughts and systems in a critical manner. In addition, it also threw light on the interpreting of Indian and Western knowledge system and strategies to restoring Indian knowledge systems which resulted into very creative queries on the part of the participants.</p> <p>The unique feature of the programme was that it was truly an academic interaction which can be said to be termed as inter-disciplinary orientation as the participants belonged to many disciplines such as psychology, Sanskrit, philosophy, education and medical science. The depth of knowledge, versatility, approachability and genuineness of Prof. Paranjpe facilitated a constant and creative dialogue with the participants which are still going on through email. The familiarity of Hindi language of Prof Paranjpe helped to increase interaction and made his presentations malleable to the participants.</p> <p>All the lectures of the programme were recorded by Educational Multimedia Research Centre (EMRC) of the university which is going to be converted in a Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) by coordinator. This programme had lasting impacts on the academics of the department and the university, as it paved the route of regular interaction with the external faculty. The first observable impact of the programme was that department of psychology has framed two courses on Indian psychology for its masters level programme. In future, it is hoped that research projects and conferences will be proposed and organized by the department. In essence, the one week programme had many significant impacts for the faculty, researchers and students.</p>

Prof, Uday Jain, a well known social psychologist of India with a international reputation was the expert from host institute who facilitated the organization of tutorials.
